Order of Draw (Tube Guide)



Collect Aerobic first, Aerobic **Common Tests:** then Anaerobic. Do not **Anaerobic Blood Cultures** Gently invert 8 times to Sodium **Common Tests:** mix. Citrate tubes must INR, D Dimer, Coag Citrate be filled to line. **Common Tests: ACD** Gently invert 8 times to mix. **HLA Phenotyping Common Tests:** Serum Troponin, LFT, U&E, CMP, Gently invert 8 times to mix. FE Studies, BSL, CRP **Common Tests: Plain** Gently invert 8 times to mix. Serum for storage Lithium **Common Tests:** Gently invert 8 times to mix. Karyotype, Flow Cytometry Heparin **Common Tests:** EDTA (4mL) FBE, Tacro, HbA1C, ESR

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Gently invert 8 times to mix. **Common Tests:** Blood Bank tubes must be EDTA (9mL) Blood Group and Hold, Blood signed + collector's declaration Group antibodies, Crossmatch on form must be signed.

Trace Common Tests: Gently invert 8 times to mix. Aluminium, Zinc, Lead Elements

Quantiferon **Common Tests:** Shake tubes vigorously TB Gold Quantiferon Gold 10 times to mix.

Fluoride Common Tests: Gently invert 8 times to mix. **Oxalate** GTT, Lactate, Ethanol

NOTE: When collecting blood via a capillary collection method (heel/finger prick), the order of draw is: blood gas syringe, EDTA tubes, sodium citrate tubes, all other anticoagulant tubes, serum/clot tubes. VBG should be done on a separate collection.
