

Your Doctor has asked you to collect a sputum specimen for Pathology testing.

Collect your sputum first thing in the morning before eating, drinking or smoking.

Rinse your mouth with water.

A deep cough from the lungs is needed to produce an adequate sputum sample.

Cough the sputum into the yellow-topped container. Screw the lid on the container and close tightly.

Write your full name, date of birth and the date and time of the collection on the container.

Take the container and your request form to an Austin Pathology Collection Centre.

Note: Saliva or spit cannot be used for this test.
